## Principal's Message

Dear Parents and Guardians

There is some exciting news on the facilities front. Due to careful management of the facilities budget over the past three or four years the college is in a good position to make a couple of significant investments in school infrastructure. At the last School Council meeting it was decided to purchase fixed seating for our theatre. This is something that has been on our wish list for quite a few years now and it will greatly enhance our ability to present school performances, lectures, meetings and assemblies.

The other major item will be the purchase of a new 25 seater Mazda (Rosa) bus. This is another item we have been dreaming about over the past 10 years. The bus will allow class groups of students to a variety of sporting, outdoor and educational venues efficiently and economically. We are hopeful that this purchase can be made in the New Year.

The City of Casey Executive Management has approved a proposal to enter a joint use agreement with Kambrya College whereby both the Council and the College will contribute funds towards developing an A Grade AFL and Cricket ground on what is affectionately referred to as the 'back paddock' at the College. This is the most economical way for the college to develop a first rate sporting facility on our school grounds. The facility will be available to community sporting clubs after school hours through the City of Casey. It will be a brilliant addition to our college and is expected to be completed by the end of 2013.

## Year 11 Netbook return

Please note that as per the agreement, Year 11 students must return their netbooks to the College at the end of the academic year. All Year 11 students must return their netbooks on Tuesday 13<sup>th</sup> November. This is the first day of their Year 12 commencement and will be facilitated in a whole year level assembly. In the event that a student is not returning to the College to complete Year 12, then he/she must ensure that they have returned their netbook to the IT department directly prior to Thursday 8<sup>th</sup> November. Students must ensure that the laptop is clean, fully charged and that they have completed a back-up of all their data. The netbooks will then be re-formatted and no data will be retrievable. If the netbook is in its original hard case, it must be returned. If the student has since purchased a soft copy bag, they may retain it, but should still ensure that they bring it on the day to ensure that the netbook is returned safely.

## VCE BOOKLIST 2013

**Parents of students in VCE** - please note that on the booklist for 2013 Physical Education 1&2 and 3&4, Biology 1&2 and 3&4, Information Technology 3&4 and Chemistry 3&4 are "New Editions for 2013". They are essentially exactly the same as the 2012 books the only difference is that with the new editions students can access a copy of the book online and not with a CD as in previous editions.

We are advising parents of this so you will be able to purchase 2012 second hand books from students in year 11 and 12, or sell copies of these books and not be concerned that they are not the correct book.

**Please note that Maths, English, Legal Studies and Systems Engineering 1-4 (that have "New Edition for 2013") do have changes and so cannot be purchased second hand.**

We have been able to secure a great deal on these calculators through Haines Education. For just \$185 you will receive the calculator plus a protective pouch, delivered to the school for the beginning of Commencement.

A big thank you to Jake Ryan for umpiring the game and allowing it to flow freely.


## KAMBRYANS IN THE KITCHEN
